"Seek ye out of the book of the LORD, and read: no one of these shall fail, none shall want her mate: for my mouth it hath commanded, and his spirit it hath gathered them." (Isiah 34:16)

None Shall Want Her Mate

Most Bible scholars and teachers interpret the above verse to mean that no prophecy given in the Bible will go unfulfilled. Each prophecy will have its fulfillment, or mate.

Interestingly in checking nineteen different Bible translations of this verse, nine of the translations, including the King James version, use the feminine pronoun "her". Most of the remaining translations use the translation "its mate".

If a prophecy, which the Bible states:

"came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost",

is referred to in the feminine then what or who would be the masculine fulfillment or "her mate". Revelation 19:10 states: "..the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy." Another clue may be the words "gathered them" in the above verse.

Matthew 24:31 says:

"He (Jesus) shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other." Matthew 24:31

Could it be the prophecy that is given by the Holy Ghost is given in the feminine and the fulfillment given in the masculine, Jesus?

Is there really a possibility that this could be true?

The book of Genesis, chapter one, would seem to confirm this is a possibility.

"God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them." Genesis 1:27. Every major Bible translation uses the words "male and female".

When speaking of "her" there is a "her or she" that is very favorably spoken of in the Bible, especially in the book of Proverbs. The name given to 'her' in the Bible is 'Wisdom'.

The following verses from Proverbs, chapter three, helps to bring this point forward.

"She is more precious than rubies: and all the things thou canst desire are not to be compared unto her. Length of days is in her right hand; and in her left hand riches and honour. Her ways are ways of pleasantness, and all her paths are peace. She is a tree of life to them that lay hold upon her: and happy is every one that retaineth her. The LORD by wisdom hath founded the earth; by understanding hath he established the heavens." Proverbs 3:15-19

Since it is written that God created man in His image, male and female, one might ask is there a possibility the Holy Ghost, the third person of the Trinity is Wisdom.

You can decide and see what you think.

Below are more verses on Wisdom.

Wisdom crieth without; she uttereth her voice in the streets: She crieth in the chief place of concourse, in the openings of the gates: in the city she uttereth her words. Proverbs 1:20-21

So that thou incline thine ear unto wisdom, and apply thine heart to understanding; Yea, if thou criest after knowledge, and liftest up thy voice for understanding; If thou seekest her as silver, and searchest for her as for hid treasures, Proverbs 2:2-4

Get wisdom, get understanding: forget it not; neither decline from the words of my mouth.

Forsake her not, and she shall preserve thee: love her, and she shall keep thee. Wisdom

is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding. Exalt her, and she shall promote thee: she shall bring thee to honour, when thou dost embrace her.

She shall give to thine head an ornament of grace: a crown of glory shall she deliver to thee. Proverbs 4:5-9

Say unto wisdom, Thou art my sister; and call understanding thy kinswoman: Proverbs 7:4

Doth not wisdom cry? and understanding put forth her voice? She standeth in the top of high places, by the way in the places of the paths. She crieth at the gates, at the entry of the city, at the coming in at the doors. Proverbs 8:1-3

Before the mountains were settled, before the hills was I brought forth: While as yet he had not made the earth, nor the fields, nor the highest part of the dust of the world.

When he prepared the heavens, I was there: when he set a compass upon the face of the depth: When he established the clouds above: when he strengthened the fountains of the deep: When he gave to the sea his decree, that the waters should not pass his commandment: when he appointed the foundations of the earth: Then I was by him, as one brought up with him: and I was daily his delight, rejoicing always before him. Proverbs 8:25-30

Wisdom hath builded her house, she hath hewn out her seven pillars: She hath killed her beasts; she hath mingled her wine; she hath also furnished her table. She hath sent forth her maidens: she crieth upon the highest places of the city, Proverbs 9:1-3
