## They that understand among the people shall instruct many." (Daniel 11:33) They That Understand

A recent poll conducted by Reuters shows that "nearly 15 percent of people worldwide believe the world will end during their lifetime. (2012)

"Whether they think it will come to an end through the hands of God or a natural disaster or a political event, whatever the reason, 1 in 7 think the end of the world is coming,"

said Keren Gottfried, research manager at Ipsos Public Affairs, which conducted the poll for Reuters. The figure is 22 percent in the US.

"About 1 in 10 people globally also said they were experiencing fear or anxiety about the impending end of the world in 2012."

If the poll is correct, then over 600 million people around the world are experiencing fear and anxiety with over 60 million in the US alone. Could this be leading to the fulfillment of Luke 21:26 which we have quoted in previous posts?

These poor people simply do not know the truth that is in God's Word, the Bible, hence our referencing the opening scripture of Daniel 11:33:

"They that understand among the people shall instruct many." Another article (2012):

"A Call to Everyone in the World to Send a Letter to the Pope" published by "The Temple Mount and Land of Israel Faithful Movement" is another example of the importance of our need to understand Biblical prophecy, both Old and New Testaments.
